We will happily accept a provisional booking but confirmation with a non-refundable deposit of 10% is required to guarantee your preferred date.



CONDITIONS OF BOOKING

All visitors must abide by the rules and byelaws of Surbiton Golf Club.

Start times will normally be between 9am and 10am for morning rounds and between 1pm and 3pm for afternoon rounds but can be subject to change. Start times must be strictly adhered to and only yellow tees used. Preferred formats are 3 ball Stableford or Foursomes or Greensomes. Texas or other forms of Scramble are not permitted.

Final numbers must be confirmed with our Office at least one week prior to the day of play. Unless the Club is notified of reductions in numbers, a full charge will be made for the last number received.

Final payment for all bookings and expenses is required on the day unless previously agreed with the Office.

Dress Code: At Surbiton we like to treat our members, their guests and our visitors in the same way and extend a warm welcome to all. As a result, we have a simple dress code that applies to everyone and we kindly ask that anyone who visits the Club complies with the Club's dress code both on the course, and in and around the clubhouse, to maintain the Club's high and consistent standards.

- 1. On the Course: Please wear smart golfing clothing and footwear (i.e., metal spike, soft spike, or dimple sole golf shoes). Predominately white socks should be worn with shorts (no black socks please), skirts and three-quarter length trousers.
- 2. In and around the Clubhouse: Unless otherwise advised (e.g., events where jacket and tie or other clothing is specified) you are welcome to wear smart casual attire, but please ensure that it is both clean and dry. Please also comply with the clear guidance below:
 - a) Blue denim clothing is not worn at any time
 - b) The emphasis at all times is on smart clothing. Clothing and footwear that is scruffy, torn or work-soiled or that might be considered more appropriate on a beach, poolside or other sporting arenas should be avoided at all times. A good rule of thumb is; if you are in any way unsure then please don't wear it, or at the very least ask a member of staff first
 - c) Shirts should be tucked in at all times i.e., on the course or in and around the Clubhouse
 - d) Gentlemen are required to wear socks with all styles of footwear in and around the Clubhouse
 - e) Golf shoes are not worn in the Lounge and Bar area. They may be worn anywhere else provided that they are clean and dry

The Captain's Committee, General Manager, House Manager, Stewards and Professionals are empowered to ensure that all aspects of the dress code are observed. Please respect and support their efforts to maintain standards.

Children under the age of 12 years are not permitted on the golf course with societies. All players are expected to have attained a reasonable standard of golf and knowledge of the 'Rules of Golf' and should have an official club or society handicap.

Surbiton Golf Club does not accept responsibility for visitors' property. You are advised to be vigilant and not leave valuable property unattended.

Only wide wheeled trolleys are acceptable. The use of mobile phones or other electronic devices are not permitted on the Course or in and around the Clubhouse except the lobby and the car park. During winter times (October to March) we do have a winter wheel policy.

Health and Safety: It is recommended during the winter months that spiked golf shoes are worn and that you avoid stepping on the various wooden sleepers, which can become very slippery. Golfers must at all times be realistic about their playing abilities. If you think there is a chance you may hit a shot close to others, wait until your range is clear.

HOW TO FIND US

From the Hook roundabout on the A3 take the A309 signposted Esher. As the A309 bridges over the A3 (approx. 300 yards) turn left into Woodstock Lane. The entrance to Surbiton Golf Club is approximately 600 yards on the right.

To get to the Hook roundabout:

A3 southbound - Hook is the one after Tolworth, go underneath the Hook roundabout underpass and immediately take the left fork (A309).

A3 northbound - go past Hook, come off at Tolworth and back on to the A3 southbound and then follow instructions as above.

From the Scilly Isles – take signs for London and the A3. Make sure you fork left on to the A309. Go round the Hook roundabout and back on to the A309 as above.

From Kingston (Surbiton) and Chessington directions simply turn onto A309 from the roundabout when you reach it.
